

Tourney Notes



Admission (wristbands will provide admittance to all sites)

Adults 18-64: \$8 daily; \$15 for 2-day pass

Kids 6-17: \$3 daily; \$5 for 2-day pass

Adults 65+ & Kids 0-5: Free

Coaches – coaches will be provided a wristband when they sign in at the venue for their first game. A maximum of **THREE** wristbands will be provided for each team - these can be allocated to either tournament coaches or members of coaching staff - any additional wristbands must be purchased.

Scorers/Timers – provided by Wisconsin Impact. **No team personnel, parents, etc. will be allowed at the scorer's table during games.**

Athletic Trainers - provided at each site by Wisconsin Impact.

Concessions – available at both facilities - no carry-ins allowed!

Apparel - apparel will be available for purchase at each site.

Basketballs – The officials will choose a basketball from among the warm-up basketballs provided by each team. **Please note that Wisconsin Impact hosts “non-shooting” events:** players/spectators will not be allowed to dribble on the sidelines or shoot during breaks. Please communicate to your families that no basketballs should be brought into the gym other than what your team will use during warm-ups, and those basketballs should only be used during that time!

Prizes – up to 12 prizes will be awarded for the 1st and 2nd place teams in each division.

Tie-breakers – Seeding criteria: Pool place (only relevant for divisional seeding); record; head-to-head (only relevant for pool finish); point differential in all games; and points allowed in all games. Note that after a tie is broken the tie-breaking rules are not reapplied - the original criteria is used unless that results in a tie, in which case the tie breaking rules are reapplied from the start for the tied teams until the tie is broken, with a random draw as the last option. Note that the maximum point differential for any given game is 15 points.

Start times – Games will not start earlier than the scheduled start time.

Eligibility – a team may only use players that are expected to play with the high school program in the 2017-18 season - graduated players are not allowed, and players younger than incoming 9th graders are only allowed with tourney permission.

Forfeit Rule – a forfeit will be awarded (with a 15-point differential) in the event that one team cannot field a team of 5 rostered players within 5 minutes after the scheduled tip-off. Programs that forfeit games risk being denied entry into the tournament in future years.

Disclaimer – Wisconsin Impact is not responsible for injury or loss of personal items. All decisions made by the tournament directors are final.

Game Rules

All games will be officiated per WIAA rules with the following exceptions:

Game Length - Games will consist of two 15-minute halves with the clock stopping on all dead balls. In the second half, while the margin is 30+ points, the clock will only stop for timeouts and injuries.

Warm-Up Length - from conclusion of prior game until scheduled start time (minimum of 3 minutes if we are running late).

Halftime – 3 minutes (may be shortened as necessary to stay on schedule).

Timeouts – 3 30-second timeouts. Timeouts do not carry over to overtime, but each team is awarded one timeout for the first overtime only.

Overtime – first overtime is 2 minutes with stopped clock. Second overtime is sudden death and is decided by the first team to score 2 points.

Fouls / Free Throws - players are disqualified on their 6th personal foul. Double bonus on the 10th team foul each half - no single bonus.

Technical / Intentional Fouls – 2 points and the ball; player technicals count as personal fouls; if a player or coach receives 2 or more technicals in a game they are ejected for the remainder of that game.
